# SAFE AND SECURE NUCLEAR ENERGY

## INTRODUCTION

Nuclear security and safety are nowadays more important issues than ever. The Fukushima nuclear power plant accident, the latest IAEA's report about Iranian nuclear program or the future need to increase production of nuclear energy in order to meet the growing energy consumption around the world are only some of the pressing topics related to the field of nuclear safety and security.

Therefore, the Association for International Affairs and the Embassy of the Republic of Korea have decided to hold an expert roundtable, on occasion of the IAEA Annual Conference in Vienna in September and the upcoming **Nuclear Security Summit in Seoul**, to cover some of the most relevant nuclear security and safety issues for the Czech and Korean security, political and energy communities.

The expert roundtable intends to focus on selected aspects of Czech, Korean, as well as international nuclear safety and security. The topic will be presented by prominent experts from the Czech and Korean nuclear energy community. Deputy Director of Energy Section at MOFAT (Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade) from the Republic of Korea will focus on **nuclear safety and security in the international context**. Representative of the NRPI (National Radiation Protection Institute) will give a speech about **reaction to nuclear accidents** and their consequences. Expert from the Nuclear Research Institute Řež will speak about Czech **nuclear security and stress tests**. Last but not least, expert from the State Office for Nuclear Safety will focus on the **protection of nuclear materials and prevention of their illicit trafficking**.
